Welcome to PLG Kids Academy

At PLG Kids Academy, we believe that well-trained staff and a great curriculum give children with a great advantage in their education and overall well-being.

Teachers at PLG Kids Academy use the Creative Academic Curriculum as their academic curriculum, supplemented with their own ideas and knowledge. This is a year-long curriculum designed specifically for toddlers and preschoolers. It includes a complete program of developmentally appropriate activities based on the child's age. 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PLG Kids Academy Payment Policy

1. The school year begins mid-August and ends in June.
2. Tuition fees are paid monthly and are due in advance on the first business day of each month.
3. We accept cash, checks, and cards (3% transaction fee applicable). Please make sure to take a receipt for all cash payments.
4. A late fee of \$5.00 per day per child will be added after the third business day if payment is not received on time or the services will be suspended immediately.
5. Registration and all other one-time fees are non-refundable. The tuition fee paid for the following two weeks is also non-refundable.
6. Full monthly tuition fee is due even if the child is absent during all or some days of such month, except for the one month in which the child is taking the "one free week" for vacation per school year. In such a month full monthly payment minus one week's fee will be due. For more information, please inquire at the office about our "Vacation Policy". PLG does not prorate tuition for Illness, National Holidays or Disasters.
7. Additional one-time fees might be collected from children for our "Summer Camp", "Winter Camp", "Graduation Ceremony", and special events including "Fieldtrips".
8. Parent/Guardian who fails to pick up their child by 5:30pm will pay a \$5.00 per minute per child late fee directly to the staff. This late fee is due at pick up time.

Sick Child Policy

In order to minimize the spread of illness in our school, we strictly enforce our Sick Child Policy. **Parents are required to comply with this policy.** Failure to do so will result in the dismissal of the student.

If a child has a health problem, parents will be notified as soon as the condition becomes apparent. Parents will be contacted first at their listed phone numbers. If a parent cannot be reached, all other authorized persons on the enrollment form will be contacted until a responsible adult takes responsibility for picking up the child.

Each parent is advised to respond promptly to the center when notified. **Each parent must present a certificate of return to school before the child will be accepted back at the center.**

The center has a No Nit-No Lice policy. If a child has either of these conditions, a nurse's note from the county health department or a physician's note must be presented before the child may return to the center. Any child with such a condition will be re-inspected upon return to the center. Parents must await the results of the re-inspection before leaving the child at the center.

Attention Parents/Guardians Children with any of these symptoms can't attend school:

- ✓ **Diarrhea:** Children will be sent home and be free of symptoms for 24 hours before returning to school.
- ✓ **Vomiting:** Children will be sent home and be free of symptoms for 24 hours before returning to school.
- ✓ **Fever:** Fever is defined as having a temperature of 100°F or higher (a child needs to be fever free for a minimum of 24 hours before returning to school, that means the child is fever free **without the aid of Medicine**), or any other fever reducing substance.
- ✓ **Green runny nose or red eye:** This indicates an infection and needs to be checked by a doctor.
- ✓ **Breathing trouble:** sore throat, swollen glands, loss of voice, hacking or continuous coughing.
- ✓ **Frequent scratching:** of body or scalp, lice, rash, or any other spots that resemble childhood diseases, including ringworm.
- ✓ **Child is irritable:** continuously crying, or requires more attention than we can provide without hurting the health, safety or well-being of the other children in our care.
- ✓ **Medications:** cannot be administered without written permission from the parent and a prescription from the doctor. Over the counter medications cannot be administered at all unless the doctor prescribes it in writing.

We will call you if your child exhibits any of the above symptoms.

If a student becomes ill at school and is unable to remain in class, the school will require prompt pickup by a parent/guardian or designated emergency contact. Failure to respond within the required timeframe(1hour) will result in emergency services being contacted to ensure the child's safety.
